Please note the following reporting revisions for three quantitative porphyrin tests - uroporphyrin I, deuteroporphyrin and mesoporphyrin will no longer be reported.

There has been no change in method, cut-off values or reference intervals.

Porphyrins Quantitation, 24 hr Urine

Uroporphyrin I will no longer be reported. If uroporphyrin I is detected and could contribute to the interpretation of the porphyrin pattern, a comment will be included in the report.

Porphyrins Quantitation, Random Urine

Uroporphyrin I will no longer be reported. If uroporphyrin I is detected and could contribute to the interpretation of the porphyrin pattern, a comment will be included in the report.

Porphyrins Quantitation, Feces

Uroporphyrin I will no longer be reported. If uroporphyrin I is detected and could contribute to the interpretation of the porphyrin pattern, a comment will be included in the report.

In addition, deuteroporphyrin and mesoporphyrin will no longer be reported. Both provide little diagnostic value to interpretation, and both are excluded in all current porphyrin testing guidelines.
