[Drug Screen Broad Spectrum LC-MS/MS, Random Urine](#)

Effective October 3, 2022, the report name for Citalopram will be revised to “Citalopram/Escitalopram”. Citalopram and escitalopram are enantiomers. Enantiomers cannot be distinguished from one another in the broad spectrum drug screen method as they have the same molecular weight and mirror structure. Therefore, when either compound is detected, the results should be reported more appropriately as positive for “citalopram/escitalopram”.
