Re: Procalcitonin

Procalcitonin (PCT) is a biomarker for early detection of systemic bacterial infection. In 2017 the US FDA approved PCT for initiating or discontinuing antibiotics in lower respiratory tract infections and discontinuing antibiotics in patients with sepsis. Studies have demonstrated that PCT-guided antibiotic treatment in conjunction with clinical judgement can reduce treatment duration without adverse outcomes. Antimicrobial Stewardship programs at many institutions are working with ICU, ED and pediatric clinicians to develop local PCT testing guidelines.

ICL offers <u>Procalcitonin</u>, <u>Serum/Plasma</u> service at St. Michael's Hospital, Toronto. Results are usually available within 24 hours of receipt at ICL and within 2 hours of receipt at the testing lab.

## Pricing for Procalcitonin testing at ICL

The price for procalcitonin analysis through ICL has been **significantly reduced** to be less than typical in-house testing costs and should allow for improved access to this important biomarker.
